2. Avoid placing the equipment near any source of heat or open flame, such as heaters, ovens, fires, candles, or any location that could generate high temperatures.
3. Ensure that children and pets are kept away from the equipment and its accessories to prevent injury or equipment malfunction.
4. This product should only be used within a temperature range of -2° to 45° Celsius. Avoid using it in extreme temperature conditions.

5. When charging, connect the plug carefully and avoid prolonged use after full charge to preserve the equipment's battery. Do not rely on direct charging as the only means of battery maintenance.

6. Before skipping rope, prepare your body. Warm up your joints and muscles to prevent strain or injury and promote better blood circulation.

7. After your workout, it is recommended to stretch, especially focusing on the legs to alleviate muscle tension or soreness.

Installation Steps

Step 1

Insert the rope through the large hole of the buckle, then thread it through the turning head at the top of the handle.



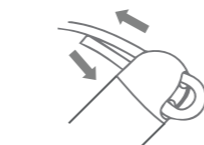
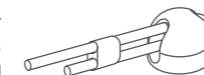
Step 2

Rotate the rope and guide it through the hole on the opposite side of the turning head.



Step 3

Secure the rope by clamping it into or threading it through the small hole of the buckle. This completes the handle and rope assembly. Adjust the buckle position for personalized grip and usage habits.



Rope Length Adjustment

To adjust the rope length to your height:

Stand upright, center the rope under your feet, and hold both handles at hip height. Stretch the rope taut to measure the ideal length, ensuring the handle aligns with your elbow joint. For best performance, the rope should be long enough to promote gradual improvements in agility and speed but short enough to maintain control. Adjust the length and secure the buckle. If necessary, trim any excess rope for safety and efficiency.

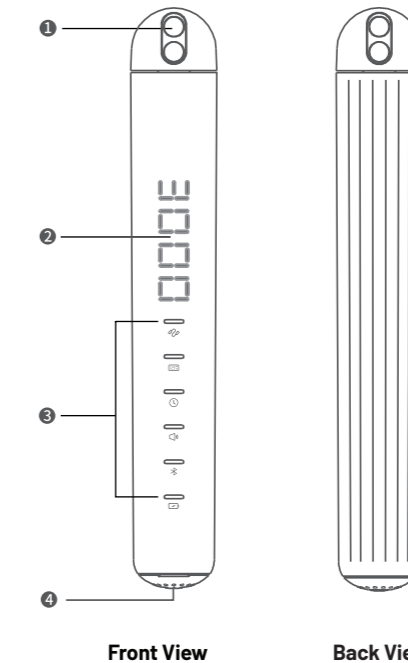

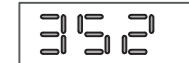


Front View

1. Swivel:

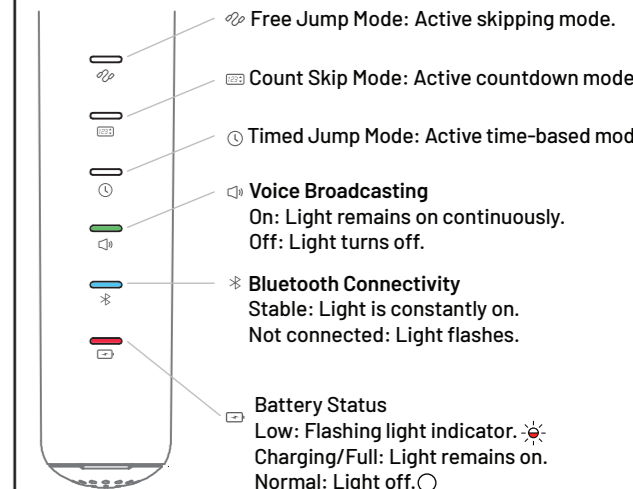
Designed for securing the skipping rope.



2. LED Light Display:

Free Jump Mode: Shows the number of skips.
 Count Skip Mode: Displays the countdown timer.
 Timed Jump Mode: Shows countdown in seconds.
 Charging Mode: Indicates current battery level.

3. Status Indicator Description:

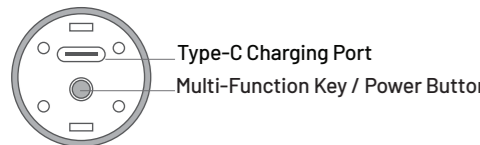


4. USB Charging Port

Open the cover gently at the handle's end to reveal the USB charging port.

Full charge is achieved in 60 minutes, providing up to 28 hours of operational time and up to 30 days in standby mode.

Connections and Indicators



Long Press (2 seconds): Power On/Off
Double Press: Toggle Voice Broadcast On/Off
Short Press: Cycle through modes

5. Multi-Function Button Operations

1. To power on from the off state, press and hold the button for 2 seconds.
2. To pause the skipping function, press and hold the button for 2 seconds when active without motion; it will pause.
3. To end a workout session, enter any mode (free jump, timed jump, or count jump) and press briefly to stop.
4. In timing or counter modes, if the rope reaches the set target number, press the key briefly to stop the session.
5. Activate or deactivate voice broadcasting with a double press.
6. Reset the device by pressing the button five times consecutively.

Timer Customization

Standard timer for count skip mode is set to 60 seconds, but the preset times of the timer can be adjusted up to 3000 counts via the app.

TUYA App Installation

For Android:

Compatible with Android 6.0+, Magic UI 2.0+, EMUI 8.0+, and higher. Download the TUYA app from the Google Play Store or scan the provided QR code for the latest version.



For iOS:

Compatible with iPhone4 and above; requires the latest iOS version. Download the TUYA app from the App Store or use the QR code to obtain the latest version.



FAQ

Fault prompt	Solution
Unable to turn on.	Verify the device's power status and attempt to recharge the product.
No sound broadcasting.	The audio may be disabled. Reactivate by double-clicking the power button.
APP: Unable to connect	-Ensure the mobile phone's Bluetooth or GPS is activated. -Power on the device's handle to connect.
The cordless ball detaches during use.	Confirm the rope buckle's proper installation as per guidelines.
Rope detaches during use.	Inspect for obstructions in the swivel's groove that could impede the rope.
Rope buckle detaches during use.	-Ensure the rope is threaded through the rope buckle's large hole first, then the small hole during setup. -Check that rope risers are correctly installed.

Note: Some issues may be resolved by restarting the device. If problems persist and cannot be addressed using the provided solutions, please contact the after-sales customer service team for assistance.
